

CHAPTER 3 SECTORAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

It analyzes the situation of the barangay and identifies the land issues and conflicts, the sectoral needs, issues and concerns to be addressed, opportunities and potentials that can be tapped, causes & effects of the core problems, the poverty situation and provided revenue generation and allocation.

ECONOMIC

AGRICULTURAL SECTOR

A.Existing Situation

Crops

An area of 273 hectares or 64.23 % of the total land area is classified for agricultural land use. The major crops grown are Coconuts, Sugarcane, Banana and Rice. The areas devoted to the production of Banana and coconuts are to be maintained, while the existing areas cultivated to lowland palay, sugarcane and coconut can still be expanded to miximize agricultural land resource utilization.

There is a massive use of inorganic fertilizers and chemicals. Usually practiced is monocropping using inbred rice and corn seeds.

Fisheries

A total of fifty four (54) hectares is presently devoted to fish ponds. About one hundred thirty-six (136) hectares is considered the Strategic Agriculture and Fishery Development Zone (SAFDZ) which is about one hundred twenty three (123) households are dependent are engaged in off-shore fishing.

Fishing gears that are mostly used by fisherman are the beach seine, gill net, skimming net, hand line, tune hand line, fish pot and multiple hand line.

Poultry and Livestock

Livestock and poultry raising help farmers augment their income thru backyard raising and usually for domestic consumption purposes. The poultry and livestock are disposed of during emergency cases usually for medical and educational needs of the family members. Poultry and livestock are also raised and domesticated for butchering during celebration of patronal fiestas and family events such as weddings, birthdays, school graduations and deaths, including anniversaries which are annually observed by the residents.

Like other agricultural products the bulk of animal and poultry products are sold to agents (buyers) coming from outside of the barangay and municipality. Production level is minimal due to high cost of commercial feeds. Feeds commonly used in home-made with no formulation analysis in protein content. Most chicken have no proper houses to live in only big trees are being utilized. Cows and carabaos are used as draft working for additional income in farming activities.

Regulatory Service

There were Barangay Ordinances adopted/implemented:

- Imposing penalties to stray animals damaging crops
- Illegal fishing in river, sea and other water bodies.

B. Situational Analysis

In order to fully develop the agricultural land resources, the following are issues and problems ;

1. Insufficiency of irrigation water to supply the needs of agricultural and other commercial crops.
2. Improvement and maintenance of farm to market roads.
3. Provision of Pre and Post harvest facilities.
4. Lack of marketing network and linkages
5. High cost of farm inputs.
6. Weak cooperative organizations
7. Lack of fishing nets & gears
8. Lesser fishcatch due to increasing no. of fisherfolks
9. Lack of technical assistance to prevent banana's diseases
10. Absence of agro-chemical suppliers for farm inputs.
11. Lack of farm equipment's for land preparation
12. Lack of financial support/capital for the livelihood projects for Women's and Fisherfolks' Association.
13. Provide trainings and seminars of soap making, food processing and other related programs for women's and fisherfolks.
14. Formulation of Barangay Ordinance creating Market Day.
15. High cost of hybrid livestock and lack of its technology
16. Unwillingness of farmers to complete the Farmers' Field School for 15 weeks
17. The Barangay ordinances are not properly implemented because of the lack of political will and vigilance to enforce the laws.
18. Lack of Information Dissemination Campaign on ordinances that caused there violators of the laws
19. Low production due to mixed cropping farming practice wherein the crops compete against soil nutrient, water and sunlight.

To provide appropriate programs for the increase in agricultural production in crops, poultry and livestock, fisheries specially fishing gears /equipments and farm implements for fisherfolks and farmers.

HEALTH

A. Existing Situation

There is one (1) Barangay Health Station in the barangay where services of a rural midwife is available once a week. The midwife is also responsible for the conduct of various health-related activities such vaccination and other preventive measures. Patients that needed medical attention are referred to the main health center in Poblacion about twelve(12) kilometers away. There are six (6) Barangay Health Workers; one (1) barangay Nutrition Scholar and one(1) Barangay Point Service Officer.

The leading cause of morbidity in the barangay are diarrhea and cough. These diseases are recurring and occur during rainy season. A botica sa barangay was established and is functional with medicines.

There is only one (1) complete Elementary School located centrally in the barangay. It occupies an area of 11,438 sq. meters of government-owned land. It has ten(10) teachers and ten(10)classrooms with a 34:1 enrollee-teacher ratio. In the school age population the 6-14 is 139 and 13-16 secondary level is 23 and only 5 for 17-21 tertiary level in that classification.

Data revealed that 90.31 % of the residents own a house and lot while the remaining households are renting free with or without the consent of the owner. Majority of the houses are made of strong materials comprising 51.89 %; and followed by light materials which comprised 32.68%. Some are also mixed but predominantly light materials (32.68%). Four (4%) percent households are living temporarily in salvaged or makeshift materials.

A.Existing Situation

The present road network covers a total area of 4.6 kilometers composed of 500 meters concrete Provincial road, while the graveled surface : 4.1 barangay roads and 2.5 kilometers provincial road.

For transportation, there are ten(10) units tricycle , thirty (30) single motorcycles and ten(10) trucks. More households own motorcycles because it can easily be acquired through easy monthly installment plans offered by companies elsewhere. Motorcycles are good type of transportation in the barangay because it can penetrate remote areas that cannot be reached by four-wheel cars. Some households derive their means of living by employing single motorcycles as public utility transportation.

For those who cannot afford to buy television due to poverty, they just have the radio to keep them informed as well as it is a source of recreation and relaxation to them by listening music and drama.

RIVERBANK PROTECTION PROGRAM

A.Existing Situation

There is one(1) kilometer stretch of the river linking the boundary of Barangay Balutakay and Leling. Occurrence of flash floods is observed during heavy rains and high tide at Puroks 4,3 ,7 and 8 which also destroyed adjacent farmlands.

The infrastructure and settlement or the built-up area comprises of 2 has. or 0.47 % of the total land area. There are structures like houses, purok centers, chapels, school building, solar drier which are constructed within this area

B. Situational Analysis

- The erosion and flash floods were observed in Purok 4,3, 7, & 8. during heavy rainy season
- There is an extent of riverbank caving and bank erosion
- Experienced the damage to crops
- Endangered the infrastructure and settlements within the area
- Silted river bed
- Roads becoming muddy and not passable for travelers

C. Goal

To regulate, protect and establish river control for safety against flashfloods and erosion.

D. Objectives

- To strengthen information campaign to evacuate those settlements and population along the riverbanks
- To conduct major rehab and desilting of the riverbed
- To plant trees along the reiver banks and riparian zones.
