ECONOMIC SECTOR

Agriculture

The Barangay of New Quezon_Hagonoy, Davao del Sur has a total land area of 426 hectares of fertile soil suitable to cultivation of various agricultural crops

a.4.2 Farm to Market Road

A total of 8 kilometers of farm to market roads is existing in the barangay, most of roads are graveled roads but during harvest season of sugarcane the roads destroyed by hauling heavy trucks.

a.4.4 Communication Facilities

At present, the most convenient, fastest and dependable means of communication is by the use of cellphones or mobile phones. The farmers, middlemen, buyers are normally equipped with this facility.

a.4.5 Agricultural Support Program (Credit/Financing Services)

There is a private bank, Dasuseco , Cooperatives that is operating and serving the financing needs of the farmers in the barangay ,However, credit and financing services are also available from government financing institutions and private banks in Digos City, the Capital City of the Province.

The operation of Davao Sugar Central Company at Guihing provided the much needed support of sugarcane farmers. Previous management had problems on the production area, which decreased radically. The volume of sugarcane delivered to the mill plant is far below its capacity.

3.3.4 Power

a. Existing Situation

The power needs of the barangay is supplied by the Davao del Sur Electric Cooperative, Incorporated based at Cogon, Digos, Davao del Sur. The electric cooperative is represented in the Board by a Director elected by members-consumer from the municipality. The district is assisted in performing his function responsibilities by by the district electrification Committee who are sectorally elected. The sectors represented are the government, civic, business, farmers, religious, the youth and media.

Two (2) puroks are already energized fully served. Table shows that out of 229 households 170 were energized by electric power equivalent to ----- %. Remaining households used kerosene and LPG for lighting purposes. Most of the household used wood/bamboo as kind of fuel used for cooking
