***AN ORDER ON THE REVISED GUIDELINES ON TRAVEL PROTOCOLS IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF HAGONOY, DAVAO DEL SUR***

WHEREAS, the National Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases issued Resolution No. 101 series of 2021 on February 26, 2021, approving the uniform travel protocols for land, air and sea of the Department of the Interior and Local Government, crafted in close coordination with the Union of Local Authorities of the Philippines, League of Provinces of the Philippines, League of Municipalities of the Philippines, and League of Cities of the Municipalities;

WHEREAS, the new protocols are continued implementation of proactive measures that is necessary to ensure utmost protection of the health of the Filipino people;

NOW THEREFORE, I, FRANCO MAGNO CALIDA, Municipal Mayor of Hagonoy, Davao del Sur, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. On Minimum Public Health Standards

- A. Minimum public standards, which include physical distancing, hand hygiene, cough etiquette, and wearing of face masks and face shields among others, shall be strictly implemented across all settings;
- B. Health assessment shall be strictly implemented to those coming from high-risk areas upon arrival to ensure that only asymptomatic, non-close contact individuals are allowed to travel or enter the Municipality or the Barangay concern.

SECTION 2. On Testing and Quarantine

- A. Testing shall not be mandatory for a traveler except if LGU of destination will require testing as requirements prior to travel, and such shall be limited to RT-PCR;
- B. No traveler shall be required to undergo quarantine unless they exhibit symptoms upon arrival at the LGU of destination;

C. For Locally Stranded Individuals (LSIs) or Returning Overseas Filipino Workers (ROFWs) and those coming from high-risk areas, a two (2) day old RT-PCR negative test result should be presented, however, they are no longer required to undergo quarantine unless they exhibit symptoms upon arrival. If with symptoms, the Municipal Health Officer shall conduct assessment and issue directive where the LSI or ROFW be placed under quarantine. If the quarantine shall be done at the Barangay Isolation Unit, their immediate family members will shoulder their food and personal needs.

SECTION 3. On Documentary Requirements

- A. Travel authority and health certificates shall no longer be required;
- B. Authorized Persons Outside of Residence (APORS) from national government agencies and their attached agencies must provide their identification card, travel order and travel itinerary.

SECTION 4. On Transportation

The LGU through the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) shall only provide transportation for LSIs and ROFWs upon request and coordination.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any provision of this order be deemed invalid or unconditional, the other provisions not affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. Previously issued Municipal directives which are inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect upon its approval.
