***AN ORDER SETTING TRAVEL PROTOCOLS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF
HAGONROY, DAVAO DEL SUR***

WHEREAS, the Joint Regional Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases- XI and Regional Task Force Against COVID-19 XI issued Resolution No. 01 series of 2021 on May 3, 2021, approving the Uniform Guidelines to Regulate Entry and Exit in Regional Borders of Region XI;

WHEREAS, the IATF-EID Issued Resolution No. 101, Series of 2021 dated February 26 providing guidelines on travel protocols for land, sea and air;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 14 dated April 16, 2021 was issued by Hon. Douglas RA. Cagas, Provincial Governor, setting travel protocols for travelers coming to the Province of Davao del Sur;

WHEREAS, the continued implementation of proactive measures and restrictions must be put in place in order to slow down the surge in COVID-19 cases, stop further spread of variants in the Municipality of Hagonoy, and to protect the health and lives of the Hagonoyans;

NOW THEREFORE, I, FRANCO MAGNO CALIDA, Municipal Mayor of Hagonoy, Davao del Sur, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZED PERSONS OUTSIDE RESIDENCE (APOR). Movement of the following APORs shall be allowed.

- a) Health and emergency frontline services and uniformed personnel,
- b) Government Officials and employees on official travel and business,
- c) Duly-authorized humanitarian assistance actors (HAAs), especially those transporting medical supplies and laboratory specimens related to COVID-19, and other relief and humanitarian assistance,
- d) Persons travelling for medical or humanitarian reasons, (such as but not limited to attendance to burial of next of kin, watchers of medical patients, takers of board/licensure exams processing documents, accompanying family/relatives in transporting human remains, persons accompanying the elderly or those with frail conditions, and other similar instances)
- e) Persons going to and from the airport except for those fetching LSIs/ROFs other than the vehicle driver or duly authorized by the LGU'

- f) Anyone crossing zones for work or business permitted in the LGU of destination;
- g) Public utility vehicle operators
- h) Others, that may be provided for by the PNP thru their updated list of APORs, provided further, they present identification card (ID), or certificate of employment, or travel order or itinerary, and must pass symptom screening in the barangays of destination.

SECTION 2. RETURNING RESIDENTS. Returning residents of the Municipality of Hagonoy that are non-APOR (listed in Section 1 hereof) coming from outside Region XI shall present identification card ID showing residence or any proof of residence and a Negative RT-PCR test result taken within 72 hours.

2.1 All Locally Stranded Individuals (LSIs) from any place outside of the Region XI and Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) shall also be required to present a NEGATIVE RT-PCR TEST Result upon his/her arrival. The said result must be within seventy-two (72) hours from the time the swab test was taken. If upon arrival, the test result has yet to be released, proof of swab test may be presented on the condition that the traveler will undergo quarantine at the Barangay Isolation Unit (BIU) of the Barangay concerned until the release of a NEGATIVE result;

2.2 During arrival at the airport or seaport, LSIs and ROFs shall be fetch by a LGU vehicle, upon discretion of the Municipal IATF. ROFs may opt to use private vehicle or hired public utility vehicle, provided that an Authority to Fetch or Clearance must be secured from the MIATF Secretariat prior to its travel, while the driver of the vehicle should wear a personal protective equipment. Provided further that no other persons (family members, etc.) shall accompany in the fetching of the ROFs and that such fetching and details of the itinerary shall be done in coordination with the LGU. LSIs and ROFs shall coordinate with the Barangay of destination on the exact schedule of their travel.

2.3 If the LSI is able to present a NEGATIVE RT-PCR test result and manifests NO COVID-19 SYMPTOMS upon arrival at the Municipality but coming from a high risk area, SHALL BE REQUIRED TO SUBJECT HIMSELF/HERSELF TO BE QUARANTINED in the BIU. However, those coming from a low risk area, shall be subjected to home quarantine, upon arrival at the receiving community, which will be counted as Day 1. The Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHERT) concerned shall monitor his/her condition for fourteen (14) days if coming from an area declared under Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) or Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ), and ten days if coming from an area declared General Community Quarantine (GCQ) or Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ). Should symptoms manifest, the BHERT shall impose the necessary quarantine requirements, and swabbing will be performed. If the LSI is placed under home quarantine, upon manifestation of symptoms, he/she will be immediate transferred to an appropriate isolation facility.

2.4 If no symptoms upon arrival, the LSI will undergo voluntary home quarantine for 14 days, and if no signs and symptoms still manifest during said period, the Municipal Health Officer will issue clearance

2.5 If the ROF is able to present a NEGATIVE RT-PCR test result and manifests no COVID-19 symptoms upon arrival at the municipality, he/she shall be subjected to undergo facility quarantine for fourteen (14) days.

2.6 On the 5th to 7th day of quarantine , the LSI/ROF shall undergo RT-PCR testing for free, if the tests yields a negative result, he/she shall immediately be discharged from the LGU facility and shall be advised to continue home quarantine for the remaining days of quarantine period, upon MHO's recommendation or clearance.

SECTION 3. BARANGAY ACCEPTANCE. The LSI, will be required to secure a Barangay Acceptance prior to travel.

SECTION 4. ESSENTIAL TRAVEL OF NON-RESIDENTS. Essential travel of nonresidents into the Municipality (such as, but not limited to accessing of essential goods and services, medical consultation, etc.) shall be allowed provided that any one (1) of the following is presented:

- a. Proof of appointment;
- b. Medical prescription/referral; or
- c. Any other document showing proof of essential transaction.

Provided further, that travelers shall only be allowed to stay for a maximum of twenty four (24) hour stay. Proof of accommodation and/or other adequate justification shall then be presented by travelers staying for more that 24 hours to be assessed by the BHERT the concerned barangay.

SECTION 5. TOURISM. Tourist that are nonresident of Region XI shall be allowed entry provided the following are presented:

- a. Negative RT-PCR test results taken within 72 hours;
- b. Resort booking confirmation, and
- c. StaySafe.PH application on their android mobile phones

SECTION 6. CARGOES AND GOODS. Movement of all types of goods and cargoes shall be unhampered. However, the following shall be observed:

- a. Personnel of delivery vehicles up to a maximum of five (5) persons only;
- b. Personnel shall undergo usual symptom screening protocol at the destination barangay;
- c. Strict social distancing must be observed, which may include, if necessary the putting of additional safe and humane seats or space in the vehicles.

SECTION 7. All travelers are subject to strict compliance with the Minimum Public Health Standards (MPHS) upon arrival and during their stay at the Municipality of Hagonoy.

SECTION 8. Only essential travels and those provided herein shall be allowed entry to the Municipality of Hagonoy.


SECTION 9. Existing Travel Guidelines issued by the IATF-MEID for areas placed under MGCQ , and those which will be issued subsequently hereto are hereby adopted

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any provision of this order be deemed invalid or unconditional, the other provisions not affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 11. REPEALING CLAUSE. Previously issued Municipal directives which are inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect upon its approval and will be deemed applicable until lifted or amended.
