**ESTABLISHMENT OF MUNICIPAL EPIDEMIOLOGY AND
SURVEILLANCE UNIT OF HAGONUY**

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization under the revised International Health Regulations (IHR) of 2005 requires all Members States to strengthen the core capacities for disease surveillance and response to avert occurrence and international spread of diseases and other public health threats;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (PIDSRS) is hereby adapted to address concerns and meet future challenges in the need to comply with the 2005 IHR.

WHEREAS, the PIDSRS Framework embodies an integrated functional disease surveillance and response system institutionalized from the national level down to the community level;

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Philippine Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response System (PIDSRS) is aimed at putting in place a system that would result in considerable reduction in morbidity, disability and mortality caused by communicable diseases and other conditions.

NOW THEREFORE, I, **FRANCO MAGNO CALIDA**, as Municipal Mayor of Hagonoy, do hereby order the following:

SECTION I. CONSTITUTION OF THE MUNICIPAL EPIDEMIOLOGY AND SURVEILLANCE UNIT (MESU)-

The Municipal Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit, Hagonoy, shall be composed of the following:

SECTION II. FUNCTIONS. The MESU shall perform the following functions:

1. Organize data collection and gather epidemiological data from disease reporting units.
2. Analyze data and provide feedback to health facilities and local leaders.
3. Identify and inform concerned personnel immediately of any disease or condition in their respective areas if there is an unusual trends or patterns of disease.
4. Carry out outbreak investigations.
5. Implement preliminary control measures immediately if required.
6. Forward epidemiological data to the next higher level.
7. Use epidemiological data to plan and implement communicable disease control activities.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately upon signing hereof.
