**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 16
Series of 2020**

**CREATING A FOOD SECURITY, PRICE MONITORING, AND ANTI-HOARDING
TASK FORCE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF HAGONOY, DAVAO DEL SUR AND
PROVIDING ITS GUIDELINES FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALL
COMMODITIES**

WHEREAS, on 8 March 2020, the President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation No. 22 "DECLARING A STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES" and mandated that "All government agencies and LGUs are hereby enjoined to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate CoViD-19 threat;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health has confirmed the Local Transmission of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (CoViD-19) in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the inter-Agency Task Force for the Management in Emerging Infectious Disease issued Resolution No. 11, series of 2020 on March 12, 2020 raising the Alert system for CoViD-19 to Code Red Sublevel Two (2);

WHEREAS, the full cooperation to the National Government and other agencies should be given by the Local Government Units (LGUs) in order to prevent the spread of CoViD-19;

WHEREAS, it is imperative that during this situation, the LGUs must see to it that no unscrupulous person shall be allowed to take advantage of the said situation to the prejudice and detriment of the inhabitants of Hagonoy, Davao del Sur;

NOW THEREFORE, by the power vested in me by law, I, FRANCO MAGNO CALIDA, Municipal Mayor of Municipality of Hagonoy, do hereby Order as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a Task Force on Food Security, Price Monitoring and Anti-Hoarding in the Municipality of Hagonoy, Davao del Sur to be composed by the following departments:

- a. Office of the Vice Mayor;
- b. SB Chairperson, Committee on Public Safety;
- c. SB Chairperson, Committee on Agriculture;
- d. Liga ng mga Barangay President;
- e. Department of Trade and Industry of Hagonoy, Davao del Sur;
- f. Business Permits and Licensing Office;
- g. Municipal Agriculture Office;
- h. Municipal Treasurer;
- i. Philippine National Police (PNP);
- j. Municipal Local Government Operations Officer, and
- k. Municipal Planning and Development Office.

SECTION 2.FUNCTIONS. The Task Force on Food Security, Price monitoring and Anti-Hoarding in the Municipality of Hagonoy, Davao del Sur shall have the following functions:

- a. Conduct daily monitoring of the price of goods and commodities sold in every stores, markets, convenience stores and the like in order to determine if they comply with the suggested retail price that is provided or that may be provided on the said goods or commodities by lawful authorities;
- b. Act on reports or complaints or motu proprio conduct inspections on warehouses or other places that are reported, or it may determine, to be hoarding goods or commodities;

c. File or recommend the filing of appropriate cases to persons or corporations who shall engage in over-pricing or hoarding of goods and commodities;

d. Coordinate with every barangay which are hereby mandated to cooperate in the monitoring and prevention of unwarranted price increases on goods and commodities;

e. Encourage every household through the Barangay Captains and Officials to be self-sufficient and have their families food security in place by establishing in their own backyards and small spaces of gardens for vegetables, spices and herbs, root crops, fishponds, raise poultry, hogs, and other sources of foods whatever is applicable in their vicinity or location that could help each family in these times of crisis or calamity to make the most of their home quarantine period productive; and

f. Perform such other lawful functions as may be provided by the Local Chief Executive;

SECTION 3. GUIDELINES ON THE SALE OF COMMODITIES DURING PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCIES. The following shall be the limit for individual consumers per person per day, limit for consumers per retailer, sari-sari store, restaurant and the like per day for various goods, to wit:

Multivitamins/Vitamin C	1 box or bottle (100pcs)	5 boxes or bottles (each containing 500 pcs)
Mineral Water	5 bottles – 1 liter 10 bottles – below 1 liter 1 container (5 liters)	15 bottles – 1 liter 30 bottles – below 1 liter 30 containers (5 liters)

Consumer shall mean the holder of a Quarantine Pass (QP) in every household and shall present his/her QP upon buying the commodities in all stores where he/she buys the goods.

All business establishments shall require the QP of their customers to prevent other households from hoarding any of the basic commodities.

SECTION 4.MEETINGS AND INSPECTIONS.The department Heads or Officers-in-Charge whose office is a member of the Task Force shall immediately convene in order to formulate their process and procedure in conducting inspections for this purpose;

SECTION 5.REPORTS.The Task Force shall make weekly report to the Local Chief Executive on the state of prices of goods and commodities in Hagonoy, Davao del Sur;

SECTION 6.EFFECTIVITY.This Order shall take effect immediately and shall have force and effect until and unless lifted.
