**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17  
Series of 2020**

**AN ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE GUIDELINES OF AN ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HAGONUY, DAVAO DEL SUR FROM 9:00PM OF APRIL 4, 2020 UNTIL 11:59PM OF APRIL 19, 2020 TO SUPPRESS THE SPREAD OF COVID -19 INFECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the World Health Organization declared a pandemic on the spread of the Covid-19 virus infection;

**WHEREAS**, President Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation 922 to put the country in a state of Public Health Emergency in relation to National Security;

**WHEREAS**, President Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation 929 and declared a State of Calamity in the entire country for a period of six months;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 also known as the Local Government Code provides that within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and promote health and safety and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, the Epidemiologists and Infectious Disease Specialists demand that people stay in their houses to arrest the spread of infection;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Davao Region COVID -19 Task Force (RTF 11 –COVID 19) Order No. 2020-008 dated April 2, 2020 prescribing the Guidelines for the Effective Implementation of an Enhanced Community Quarantine over Davao Region (from 9:00PM of April 4, 2020 until 11:59PM of April 19, 2020 to suppress the spread of COVID -19 Infection);

**WHEREAS**, it becomes necessary to supplement existing community quarantine guidelines under Executive Order No. 15 Series of 2020 issued on March 26, 2020 of the undersigned and impose stricter measures for this purpose;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I , FRANCO MAGNO CALIDA**, Municipal Mayor of Hagonoy, Davao del Sur, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**SECTION 1. DECLARATION.** There is a need to implement an **ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE(ECQ)**for the suppression of the spread of Covid-19 infection in Hagonoy, Davao del Sur beginning 9:00PM of 4 April 2020 until 11:59PM of 19 April 2020 unless further extended or sooner withdrawn.

**SECTION 2.ADOPTION.**The following provisions are reiterated from Executive Order No. 15; Section 1(1), (3) b,c,d,e,(3.1),(3.2),(4),(5),(9),(11),(12),(13),(14),(18),(19),(20) and Covid-19 RTF Order No. 2020-008.

**SECTION 3.GUIDELINES.** The following are amendatory and suppletory guidelines to Executive Order No. 15 as follows:

1. All government offices must work from home and leave minimal employees to continue work in offices except those involved in security, health, social services, sanitation, and disaster, who must continue to work on full operation;

2. All private establishments and offices must close EXCEPT groceries, supermarket, wet markets/ palengkes, foods processing or manufacturing, food delivery services, wholesale food outlets, sari-sari stores, hospitals, pharmacies, drugstores, other health services/personnel, banks and ATMs, savings and credit cooperatives, money-transfer services and bayad centers, other delivery services, doctor's and dentist's clinic, gas stations, water refilling stations, LPG stations, and mass media outlets. Whenever possible, skeletal workforce arrangement must be implemented and at all times physical distancing between employees must be observed;

3. All others business establishments and private offices not mentioned but are considered essential sectors, including but not limited to energy, water, telecommunications, must work only on preventive maintenance and during emergencies;

4. Manufacturing, fabrication, construction work that is not pertinent to the public health emergency and state of calamity response should immediately cease operation. Agri-business and Farms should reduce workload and extend their deadlines to significantly reduce labourers in the job site and to create a two-meter distance between labourers.

5. Ambulant food vendors who are using different modes of transportation to basic food commodities in the barangays shall be allowed. Basic food commodities shall mean rice, bread, meat, poultry, fish, fruits and vegetables, cooking oil and other food condiments. There must be a maximum of 2 workers, 1 driver and 1 assistant who shall wear face masks and shall implement proper food handling;

6. All multi-cabs must stop their operation except those hired to work for the government or offices and businesses that are open during the ECQ;

7. These forms of transportation are allowed:

- a. Private vehicles with 1 driver and 1 passenger in the front and 1 at the back, observing physical distancing.
- b. Tricycle with 1 driver and 1 passenger in the front and 1 at the back, observing distancing;
- c. Single rider motorcycle or bicycle
- d. Free service vehicles from the government

8. All individuals on the streets must carry and, whenever asked by law enforcement or barangay checkpoints, must present their employee ID or food and medicine pass with valid ID whichever is applicable;

9. Liquor Ban: Selling and serving or consumption of liquor and of alcoholic beverages, coconut wine and other beverages that may cause intoxication are prohibited within 24 – hours during the ECQ;

10. The curfew hours are 8:00PM to 5:00AM. People cannot go out of their houses, except in cases of emergencies or when reporting for work;

11. There is no need for any ID or pass in the event of an emergency;

12. The following workers are exempted from curfew, viz: those employed in government offices related to security, health, social services, sanitation, and disaster, 24 hours groceries/convenience store, wet markets/palengkes, food processing or manufacturing, food delivery services, hospitals, pharmacies, drugstores, other health services/personnel, doctor's and dentist's clinics, gas stations, and mass media outlets;

13. The food and medicine pass (FM pass) or quarantine pass shall be used to buy food, medicines or go to hospital. A Home Quarantine Pass shall only allow one (1) person per household. While the Work Pass shall be issued to every worker / employee of the household. FM or Q pass can only be used from the hours 5:00AM to 8:00PM.



14. No minor, senior citizen, pregnant women, sick, and immunocompromised individuals can go out of the residence or dwelling except to go to the hospital, medical, or allied medical institutions. If these individuals are living alone, they may secure their food or medicine pass, or whenever possible and if appropriate, may ask a neighbor or a friend to help them buy food and medicines. Whenever possible employers must assign their senior citizens to work from home.

15. Individuals are allowed to exercise or go out into the sun or get some fresh air provided that they are within the perimeter of their residence or dwelling;

16. Funeral parlors and private and public cemeteries are mandated to impose a "family members only" wake and burial and at all times must demand compliance and observance of two (2) meter distance between family members and frequent hand washing with soap and water. The wake shall last within three (3) days/nights.

17. Southern Philippines Medical Center, Digos Doctor's Hospital and Medical Center of Digos Cooperative Hospital shall be the primary hospital for severe and critical PUIs / COVID-19 patients. Other centers available for mild PUIs shall receive patients referred to them by SPMC.

18. Private hospitals shall ensure support to SPMC by conducting the following:


- a) All private hospitals are not allowed to admit PUIs and Covid-19 positive patients;
- b) Private hospitals must admit 10% or more indigent patients to decongest SPMC and allow space therein;
- c) Private birthing facilities must cater to indigent normal spontaneous delivery patients;

**SECTION 4.SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

**SECTION 5.REPEALING CLAUSE.**All orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 6.EFFECTIVITY.**This order shall take effect immediately.
