SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. **The iWaSH Council** is mainly a policy-making and coordinating body.
1. Serve as local oversight and policy making body on integrated safe water, sanitation and hygiene (iWaSH);
 2. Formulate and implement the LGU iWaSH Sector Plan, where iWaSH targets and investments are included in the AIP, LDIP, CDP and CLUP.
 3. Formulate and pass local policies to support the promotion, advocacy, implementation, and sustainability of iWaSH plans, projects and programs in the municipality;
 4. Ensure that gender equality and women empowerment, Climate Change Adaptation/Disaster Risk Reduction, and Public Private Partnership are integrated in iWaSH policies, plans, programs and projects;

5. Ensure integrity of local iWaSH governance to promote and protect the rights of local citizens to safe water, sanitation, and hygiene i.e. establish mechanisms for local participation, feedbacking, monitoring, and reporting on iWaSH issues and concerns;

6. Identify areas for development and recommendations to enhance access to and provision of safe water, sanitation, and hygiene services to target communities, especially among women and girls;

7. Ensure that performance of Water Utilities Associations / Water Service Providers are regularly evaluated in terms of providing quality, adequate, affordable and continuous safe water, sanitation, and hygiene services.

8. The responsibilities of the CSOs/NGOs:

- a. As warranted, conduct community organizing
- b. Voluntarily monitor the project implementation
- c. Participate planning and evaluation of the project
- d. Attend meetings
- e. Suggest recommendations for the improvement and sustainability of the project.

B. The **iWaSH Team** are the working force of the iWaSH Council.

1. Supervise, monitor and report to the iWaSH Council the progress of implementation of programs, plans, policies and projects on iWaSH;

2. Prepare the LGU iWaSH Sector Plan;

3. Implement, monitor and report to the iWaSH Council achievement of safe water, sanitation & hygiene targets set in the LGU iWaSH Sector Plan, and update the LGU iWaSH Sector Plan as needed i.e. increased iWaSH coverage, decrease in reported cases of water-borne diseases, the attainment of Zero Open Defecation in barangays, among others.

4. Work in close coordination with the Regional WATSAN Hub for the provision of capacity development assistance on LGU programs/projects on iWaSH.

5. Community organizing/social preparation activities for the creation and institutionalization of iBWSAs, community integrity groups, and other relevant community teams for iWaSH;

6. Sanitation interventions towards Zero Open Defecation Certification e.g. CLTS/PhATS, low-cost sanitation option in coordination with RHUBs;

- Preparation and implementation of the LGU iWaSH Sector Plan, Water Safety Plan, and Water Quality Monitoring Plan;
- iWaSH Infrastructure Development i.e. guide to the preparation of FS, DED, procurement, implementation and monitoring/reporting process.
- Communications / Promotions and Advocacy on iWaSH

7. Assist the iBWSA to set up systems, procedures, and by laws that would ensure sustained O&M of the iWaSH facilities and make available mechanisms for community consultations, reporting and feed-backing.

8. Regularly monitor and assess the performance of Water Service Providers (WSPs) (e.g. iBWASAs) to ensure the delivery of adequate, affordable, quality, and continuous services on safe water, sanitation, and hygiene.

9. Promote mutual accountability between the Water Service Providers (WSP) and water users through development of social contract known as the Localized Customer Codes (LSCs).

10. Ensure the effective and sustainable implementation and delivery of water and sanitation services through their established and institutionalized monitoring system.

11. Facilitate the recognition of newly formed Water Service Provider (e.g. iBWSA, Cooperative, Private-owned, et.al) thru SB Resolution.

SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE AND OPERATIONAL SUPPORT.

Upon the effectivity of this order, the Municipal Integrated Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (iWaSH) Council and iWaSH Team may draw its administrative, operational and budgetary requirements from the available fund of the General Fund/ MOOE – Mayor's Office.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. The order shall take effect immediately
