**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 40A**  
**Series of 2020**

**AN ORDER ORGANIZING THE POLICE AUXILIARY OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF HAGONUY,  
DAVAO DEL SUR**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 clearly states that local government unit shall ensure improve of public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, maintain peace and order and preserve the comfort and convenience of inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2008-013 dated August 21, 2008 prescribed the guidelines and procedures governing the deputation of Barangay Tanods as Members of Police Auxiliary Units (PAUs) and authorized the deployment of PNP Uniformed Personnel to Act as Supervisor of PAU members;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 25, specifies for the Whole-of- Nation Approach in attaining inclusive and sustainable peace;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to strengthen the present number of the Police and Army personnel assigned in the Municipality of Hagonoy to ensure support to internal security operations for the suppression of insurgency and other serious threats to safety and security

**NOW, THEREFORE I, FRANCO M. CALIDA**, Municipal Mayor of Hagonoy, Davao del Sur, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby **ORDER** the following:

**SECTION 1. ORGANIZATION.** There shall be organized Police Auxiliary in the Municipality of Hagonoy, Davao del Sur , viz:

**SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS.** The PAU shall perform functions that are related to law enforcement, order maintenance, information gathering within their respective barangays/localities, to wit:

- a. Gather information and report the same to the police authority;
- b. Secure crime scene until such time that it is processed by qualified PNP Personnel;
- c. Effect an arrest pursuant to the provision of the Rule 113 of the Rules of Court;
- d. Assist in law enforcement and neighborhood watch;
- e. Assist in the identification and implementation of public safety development projects;
- f. Assist in Disaster and Relief Operations;
- g. Perform other functions and duties as may be prescribed by proper authorities.

In addition, PAUs may:

- a. Be employed for the security of vital facilities;
- b. Intelligence collection in support to investigation and filing of cases against insurgents;
- c. Public information drives;
- d. Community relations and development;
- e. Humanitarian assistance activities;
- f. Deter insurgents from conducting social investigation and class analysis activities

**SECTION 3. MONITORING OF THE PERFORMANCE OF DEPUTIZED PAUs.** The members of the local PAUs shall be under the over-all supervision of the PNP.

**SECTION 4. AUTHORITY TO DISCIPLINE PAU MEMBERS.** The Chief of Police may recommend the imposition of thirty (30) days suspension or cancellation of the deputation on any of the following grounds:

- a. Disloyalty to the Republic of the Philippines;
- b. Culpable violation of the Constitution and human rights;
- c. Misconduct;
- d. Abuse of Authority.

**SECTION 5. SALARIES/WAGES/HONORARIUM/BENEFITS.** Emolument/ Compensation/ Benefits of the PAU members shall be charged to the local funds wherever and whenever is applicable.



**SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If for any reason, any part or provision of this order shall be found unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE.** Previous issuance or parts thereof in conflict with or inconsistent to the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.



**SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately after signing.
